BASIC CONFIDENTIALITY AND PRIVACY POLICY

Camso Inc. and its affiliates ("Camso") considers personal information to be private and confidential. Accordingly, the personal information you provide is stored in a secure location, is accessible only by designated staff. Camso will not disclose any personal information to third parties, other than its affiliates and business partners.

INFORMATION COLLECTION

When you browse a Camso site, you do so anonymously. Personal information is not collected. Some areas of our sites, however, may request that you voluntarily supply us with personal information, including your name, email address, etc., for purposes such as correspondence, site registration, or participating in online surveys.

Camso may also retain electronic communications you send to our customer service representatives, webmaster or other associates. These may be shared only within Camso as a means to continually improve customer service.

The site tracks information about visits to the site. For example, statistics are compiled that show the daily number of visitors to the site, the daily requests received for particular files on the site, and what countries those requests come from. These aggregated statistics are used to customize our site to better meet your needs and may also be provided to others, but the statistics contain no personal information and cannot be used to gather such information.
